Yass! New *Broad City* coming soon to Foxtel

Broad City S4 will be express from the US and first on Foxtel for Australian audiences. Episodes will be available to watch from Foxtel's on demand library, or streamed on demand on Foxtel's streaming service, Foxtel Now, for 28 days after first broadcast.
